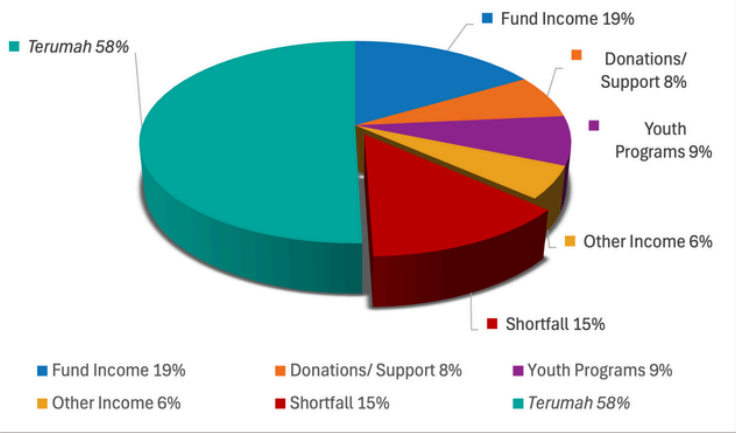

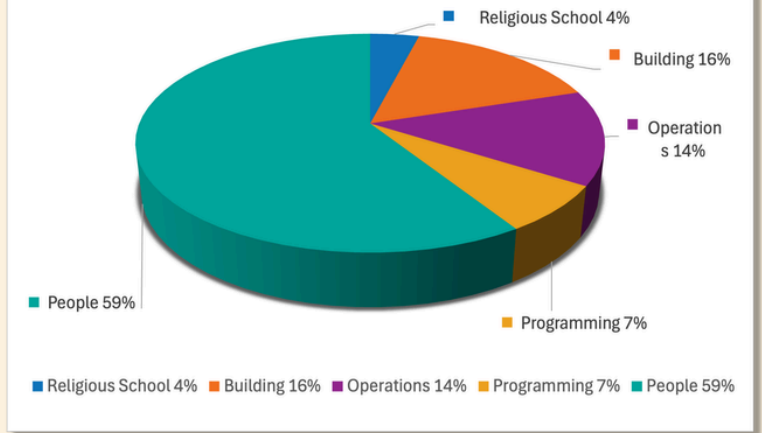

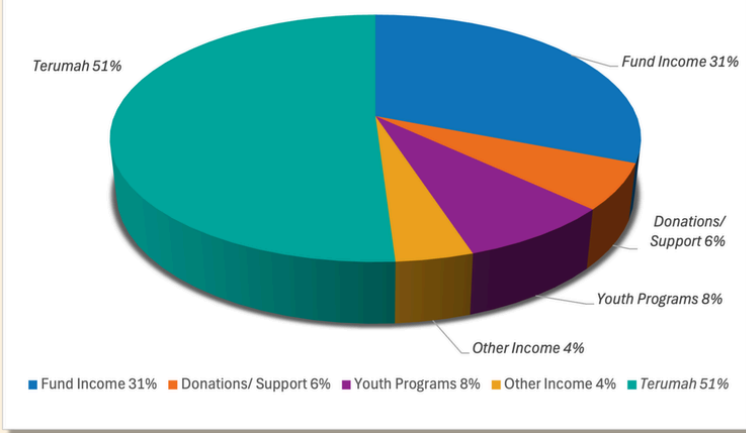
PROJECTED ACTUAL INCOME 2025-2026



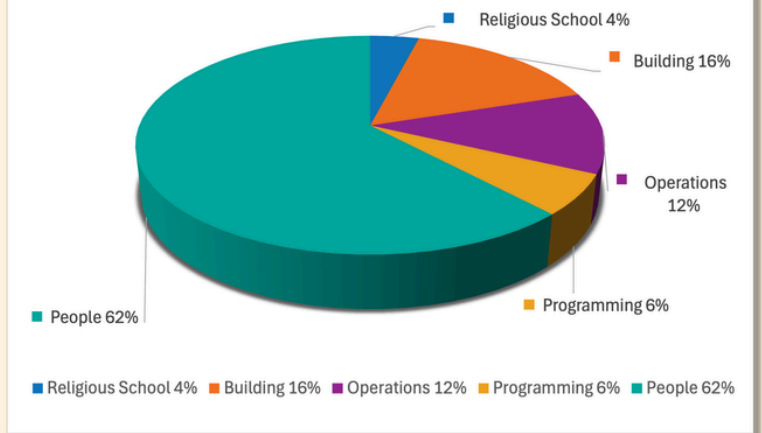
PROJECTED ACTUAL EXPENSES 2025-2026

We are deeply grateful for your continued generosity and partnership as our congregation works to build a truly sustainable financial future. Your annual support through gifts, including *Terumah*, *Ner Tamid* and Endowment contributions, makes possible the vibrant, meaningful life of our community. Because of you, we can provide strong, engaging programming for all ages, including a thriving religious school that nurtures the next generation.

As we reflect on the past two fiscal years (2024-2025 and 2025-2026), our financial results have remained consistent in scope. At the same time, we continue to face a modest shortfall for the current year. It is important to recognize that our overall budget remains significantly leaner than congregations of comparable size across the Midwest. Additionally, while many organizations categorize portions of staff compensation as programming expenses, our congregation accounts for all compensation transparently within the “People” category. This accounting approach reflects our commitment to clarity and integrity in how we report our finances.

We are especially encouraged by your extraordinary early response to our Endowment Match Campaign. Your enthusiasm and generosity have strengthened our long-term financial foundation in meaningful ways. With the growth of our Endowment funds, the annual 5% distribution now allows us to close the gap created by our prior deficit.

Because of your commitment, we are proud to share a balanced (neutral) projection for the 2026-2027 budget — an important milestone in our journey toward sustainability.

This progress is possible only because of you. Continued participation in *Terumah*, *Ner Tamid*, the Annual Campaign, general fund gifts and the Endowment Match Campaign ensures that we not only meet our obligations, but continue to grow, innovate and serve our community with strength and purpose.

We move forward together, and together, we will sustain the vibrant Jewish life that defines our congregation for today and for generations to come.
